## 'Shout!' it out

**A** nonstop journey through infectious and soulful pop anthems and ballads that made household names of Petula Clark, Dusty Springfield and Lulu, "Shout! The Mod Musical" makes its New York City debut Tuesday at the Julia Miles Theatre.

The show flips through the years like a musical magazine, tracking five young women as they come of age during the 1960s. Letters to an advice columnist, true confessions, quizzes and advertisements are used with hits such as "Downtown," "To Sir With Love," "Son of

a Preacher Man" and "Goldfinger."

In 2001, the London Times said the musical "'captures all the exuberant innocence, camp melodrama and soulful heartbreak of the 1960s diva songbook."

Opening night is scheduled for July 27.
